In Remembrance of H.M. the Late King Bhumibol Adulyadej throughout the Year 2016-2017



Following the passing of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej on 13 October 2016, President Dr. Rutchaneeporn P. Phukkamarn along with Executives, faculty members, staff, and students jointly offered food to the monks as merit making for H.M. King Bhumibol Adulyadej on October 18, 2016. The official ceremony in commemoration of H.M.'s Royal Grace and Deepest Remembrance of His Majesty the King was also organized in the afternoon at Bualuang Grand Hall. The event was attended by a great numbers of SPU Executives, faculty members, staff & students who all together sang the Royal Anthem and other songs in honor of His Majesty the late King Rama 9, with deep grief and great sorrow. The activity continued with an observation of a nine- minute moment of silence and signing the book of Royal condolences.



Volunteering Activities by SPU Executives, Faculty Members, Staff, and Students



During the mourning period for His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej, SPU Executives, faculty members, staff and students participated in volunteering activities such as making black ribbons, distributing food and drinking water, and collecting garbage at Sanamluang Ground in front of the Grand Palace.

Sripatum University Paid Tribute to His Majesty the Late King Bhumibol Adulyadej



On 22 November 2016, Executives, faculty members, staff, and students of Sripatum University attended the ceremony organized in honour of the late King Bhumibol Adulyadej. As invited by the Thai government, people all over the country paid tribute to His Majesty the late King Bhumibol Adulyadej and participated in the event called Ruam Phalang Haeng Kwam Phakdi (the United Force of Allegiance) which was taken place in many locations across the nation. At Sripatum University main campus in Bangkok, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Kanchit Malaivongs - Chairman of the

University Council led Executives, faculty members, staff, and students to express the unity, love and loyalty to His late Majesty. All participants took an oath of allegiance in front of the Royal portrait of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej, promising to follow the law and manage national resources wisely for sustainable development in line with His Majesty's Sufficiency Economy Philosophy. The ceremony was concluded by singing the royal anthem and singing a song composed by His Majesty called "The Impossible Dream" (Kwam Fan An Soong Sood).



A Ceremony to Mark the 50th Day of Mourning for HM King Bhumibol Adulyadej

On 1 December 2016, Sripatum University hosted the merit-making ceremony at Prasri Mahathat Worawihan temple to pay tribute to His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej on the occasion of the 50-day mourning period. The 50-days ceremonies "Panyasamawarn" were also held at temples around the country. At Prasri Mahathat Worawihan temple, President of Sripatum University Dr. Rutchaneeporn P. Phukkamarn presided over the ceremony which was fully attended by Executives, faculty members, students of Sripatum University, as well as participants from the public and private sectors in the area. The religious ceremony started with a sermon and chanting from the monks, followed by robes offering. Lunch was also offered to 40 monks in the temple.



SPU Co-hosted Royal Funeral Rites of the King Bhumibol Adulyadej



On 1 February 2017, Sripatum University was granted the royal permission to co-host the royal funeral rites of the late King Bhumibol Adulyadej. On this occasion, President Dr. Rutchaneeporn P. Phukkamarn led SPU Executives from Bangkhen campus, Chonburi campus, and SPU Khon Kaen to participate in the ceremony to express the contemplation of the royal grace and the gratitude towards the dedication of His Majesty. The royal funerary ritual took place at Dusit Maha Prasat Throne Hall in the Grand Palace.



The Eternal Memory : A Special Even in Remembrance of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej - The Musical Monarch



29 March 2017, Vice President for International Affairs – Mrs. Chinda Tejavanija Chang presided over the opening ceremony of "The Eternal Memory: A Special Even in Remembrance of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej - The Musical Monarch" organized by Sripatum International College. The event aimed to honor King Rama IX - Father of the Thailand and Soul of the nation, for his musical talent, as he composed more than 48 songs and became globally recognized as a talented composer and musical genius. The event was filled with student performances by students of Sripatum International College including singing the songs composed by His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej.



SIC Paid Respect to the Late Beloved King Bhumibol Adulyadej

On 25 September 2560, Vice President for International Affairs – Mrs. Chinda Tejavaniya Chang led faculty members, staff, and students of Sripatum International College to pay homage to His Majesty the late King Bhumibol Adulyadej in front of his royal portrait at building 1, Sriaptum University. On this occasion, the Vice President placed the flower trays and signed the condolence book.



Making the Royal Cremation Flowers

Sripatum University joined hands to create the royal cremation flowers which would be distributed to the public mourners during the royal cremation of the late HM King Bhumibol Adulyadej as scheduled on 26 October 2017. Led by President Dr. Rutchaneeporn P. Phukkamarn, Executives, faculty members, staff and students joined this special activity and were given the instructions on how to make the cremation flowers. Each school and office including Office of International Relations also showed the volunteering spirits receiving raw materials to make more cremation flowers in shape of Daffodil or Dararat. October 5, the Office of Student Affairs on behalf of Sripatum University handed over 14,670 cremation flowers to the representative of Chatuchak District Office.



Making the Royal Cremation Flowers

On 24 October 2017, Sripatum University organized special activity as a tribute to His Majesty the late King Bhumibol Adulyadej. President Dr. Rutchaneeporn P. Phukkamarn along with SPU administrators, faculty members, staff and students jointly participated in activities to show loyalty and gratitude to the late King. The activities included merit making ceremony with 89 monks, placing the potted yellow 100 marigolds in front of the royal portrait of the late king, an observation of eighty nine-minute moment of silence, and singing of “ Father of The Nation ”, or “Nai Luang Kong Pandin”. During this period, all SPU campuses; Bangkok, Chonburi, and Khon Kaen, are decorated with marigolds pants in dedication to His Majesty the late King, and in response to the government's call to grow marigolds or other yellow flowers as yellow represents Monday, the birthday of King Bhumibol.





Sripatum University Took Part in the Royal Cremation Ceremony for the Late Monarch

After A year-long period of mourning, the royal cremation ceremony was scheduled to take place over five days in Bangkok from October 25-29, 2017. On Thursday 26 October as the royal cremation actual day, when the sandalwood flower offering activities organized throughout Thailand and abroad, President of Sripatum University Dr. Ratchaneeporn P. Phukkamarn led Executives, faculty members, staff, an students to participate in the funeral-flower laying rituals organized at Wat Phra Sri Mahathat Woramahawihan - Buddhist monastery and meditation temple in Bang Khen. Apart from making offerings of funeral flowers in tribute to the late King Bhumibol Adulyadej, on this day, faculties and staff as well as students of Sripatum University also joined volunteering activities by distributing drinking water, taking care of elderly people and disable persons and all those ceremony participants.
