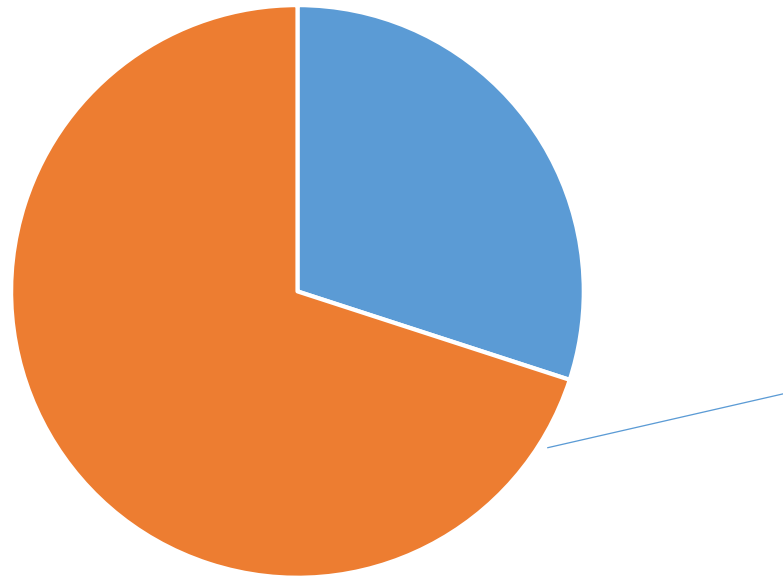


■ LECTURE / EXPERIENTIAL ■ WIL ■ ■
