Subject: Measures and Surveillance for the spreading of Corona Virus (2019-nCoV)

The evidence is highly suggestive that the outbreak of Corona Virus (2019-nCoV) is associated with exposures in Wuhan City, China. The authorities continue their work of intensive surveillance and follow up measures, as well as further epidemiological investigations. The clinical signs and symptoms reported are mainly fever, with a few cases having difficulty in breathing, and invasive pneumonic infiltrates in both lungs. The spreading of this virus is quite easy since it can be contracted via human-to-human touch and human bodily fluid that has been spreading around in the air.

We are deeply concerned with this situation. In order to prevent the spreading of the Corona Virus (2019-nCoV), we urge every students and staffs to take the measurement and surveillances as follows:

1. Chinese students who has returned home in China and has not yet come back to Thailand, please continue your stay in China for at least another 2 weeks or until SPU announced otherwise. For academic advisor please, contact the Chinese students under your care to inform the students accordingly. For this case, the curriculum will arrange supplementary class for the said Chinese students once they are safely return back in Thailand.
2. For those students who has just come back from China (after the 12th January 2020) please take some rest at home for the duration of 2 weeks after you have returned to Thailand, in order to be safely observed for the symptoms. For this measurement, the academic advisor please, inform your said students accordingly or until SPU announced otherwise.
3. For the Chinese students who are still in Thailand and has not gone back home to China, the academic advisor please, contact your said students to inform them that meeting with people who has just come back from China must be avoided to prevent the risk of contracting the virus.
4. For those students who develop the high fever symptoms or having abnormalities in their respiratory system (difficult breathing) please, contact your academic advisor/lecturer and please go to the hospital immediately for the precaution, please do not stay at home when all the said symptoms has developed and please, follow the doctor's advice strictly.
5. All SPU activities that involves or will involve the gathering of students and/or international students must be refrained from for the duration of 30 days.

6. SPU has provided the alcohol gel for your hands sanitation in front of the escalators in every buildings in the university
7. SPU asks the management team, lecturers, staffs and students to please follow the preventative measurement from the Ministry of Public Health as follows
 - (1) Drink plenty of warm water when thirsty (child 30-50 cc, adult 50-80 cc)
 - (2) Avoid being in touch with the patient and avoid being near the person when they sneeze or cough
 - (3) Avoid being in crowded places
 - (4) Wear mask at all time when being in the crowded places
 - (5) Refrain from using shared personal belonging with others for example, towel, drinking glasses and handkerchief
 - (6) Avoid going to the animal market and avoid touching or being near animal in general especially sick or dead animal
 - (7) Do wash your hands frequently with water and soap or use alcohol gel
 - (8) Avoid eating raw food, do eat only properly cooked and clean food
 - (9) Do get plenty of sleep
8. SPU asks all lecturers and academic advisor to help gather information of our students and watch out for the outbreak of the virus by following the Epidemiology principle. Should there be any irregularities or detection of the abnormalities among the students concerning the virus, please do report immediately to the University in order to get collaborated help in controlling this outbreak of the virus situation together with SPU.
